Aeropelican to commence air services from Sydney to Mudgee

Aeropelican announced today that it will be commencing direct air passenger services between Sydney and Mudgee. Subject to regulatory approval

Aeropelican is a Newcastle based independent regional airline, which currently operates services from Newcastle Airport (Williamstown) to Sydney and from Sydney to Narrabri.

Aeropelican operate a fleet of 19 seat, pressurised BAE Jetstream 32 aircraft that will operate on the Sydney - Mudgee service.
